

## Modernizing California's Water Infrastructure

The Delta Conveyance Project (DCP) is a proposal to modernize water infrastructure in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta by creating an additional point of diversion along the Sacramento River coupled with conveyance facilities in the Delta. The DCP is intended to restore and protect the reliability of State Water Project (SWP) and to ensure California's largest supply of clean water is climate resilient.
