# San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency



San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency (SGPWA) was formed to address historical groundwater overdraft by securing and managing imported supplies from the State Water Project (SWP). Today, SWP water is a critical component of the region's supply portfolio, making up about 42.5 percent of total water supplies. These imported supplies help stabilize the groundwater basin, support local communities and ensure long-term water reliability across the Pass region.




